ABOUT THE FILM

Stripped of her rights, a woman's life changes when she ventures with her husband to remedy an impossible situation.

R.V is a confronting narrative short film that follows the emotional journey of a woman as she undergoes an abortion procedure in very unsafe conditions.

- Since Roe v. Wade (1973) there have been 1142 abortion restrictions added by states.
- As of 2017, 7 states had only one facility providing abortions: Kentucky, Mississippi, West Virginia, Missouri, Wyoming, South Dakota, & North Dakota
- In 2018 nearly **90% of counties** in the U.S do not have a clinic providing abortions.

RECOMMENDED QUESTIONS

- 1. How does access to safe care affect local economics?
- 2. Can Roe vs Wade realistically be overturned?
- 3. If Roe vs Wade is overturned, what are the actual repercussions?
- 4. What measures can you take to ensure women have access to safe care on a local level?
- 5. How do you discuss reproductive rights with friends/family members who's point-of-view is rooted in their interpretation of the Bible?
